The FACwas recently invited to review three APS policies that are line to be revised: B-2, School Board; B-3.7.31, Legislative Liaison; and B-4, Compensation and Benefits for School Board Members. We have reviewed these documents and have one comment to submit on draft policy B-2.

In the section School BoardPowers and Duties paragraph 8 sets requirements for public hearings. Among those requirements in the directive is that there must be advance notice of the hearings, which must be provided to the public in a newspaper of generation in the school division \tilde{a} . The policy states that this consitutes reasonable notice. We disagree.
